Membership Discussion

- RC-2020 was founded in 1989 as a not for profit organisation.
- It aims to create an open exchange of ideas among leaders of large urban Community Colleges.
- The mission is: self-Renewal and Change by exchanging CEO views and college practices.
- There are 1200 Community Colleges in the United States.
- The maximum membership is 35 Community Colleges.
- Currently, there are 22 fee paying members.
- Membership has been declining:
 1. Sydney TAFE resigned due to strategic focus on internal work only (no international)
 2. UK Colleges (Nottingham, City and Islington and Cornwall) resigned due to retirements
 3. US Colleges resigned due to restructures and financial pressures.
- Of the 22 members, 10 are active with the remainder at varying degrees of risk.
